The Lebanon Township Education Foundation is pleased to announce a very exciting upcoming event to be held this spring in Memorial Park. The **Bourbon Street Blues Festival** will take place on Saturday, May 3rd from 1:00-8:30p.m. We anticipate that this event will be the largest fundraising event ever held in Lebanon Township, with an expected turnout exceeding 1,500 people!

The Blues Fest will be a family event, which will be fully catered and will not only feature live music and beer, but also a Kid's Tent with a full range of children's activities. The LTEF will donate 80% of the proceeds from the Blues Fest directly to the Playground Fund.
